

PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

**ORDER**

Petitioner/Plaintiff County of Los Angeles' (the "County") *Ex Parte* Application for Temporary Restraining Order and Order to Show Cause re Preliminary Injunction (the "Application") came on for hearing before this Court on April 27, 2020 at 8:30 a.m.

The Court having considered the Application together with the papers on file, as well as any oral argument of counsel, for good cause showing, hereby rules as follows:

**THE APPLICATION IS GRANTED:**

1) The Court hereby issues a TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER ordering *the City of* Norwalk to comply with the Emergency Services Act and the Governor's Executive Orders by allowing the County to implement Project Roomkey and *at the hotel in question* ~~other temporary emergency housing programs for at-risk individuals experiencing homelessness,~~ *APV*

2) The Court hereby issues a TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER enjoining *the City of* Norwalk from enforcing the Norwalk Moratorium; and *with regard to the hotel in question* ~~and~~ *APV*

3) The Court hereby issues a TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER enjoining *the City of* Norwalk from taking any actions intended to prohibit or inhibit the ability of *the hotel in question* ~~businesses in Norwalk to participate in Project Roomkey or other temporary emergency housing programs for at-risk individuals experiencing homelessness.~~ *APV*

The temporary restraining order granted herein shall expire on \_\_\_\_\_.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:**

The Court hereby issues an ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE regarding why a preliminary injunction should not issue.

The Order to Show Cause shall be set for hearing on 7-2-20 at 9:30 a.m. in Department 85 of this Court, located at 111 North Hill Street, Los Angeles, California 90012.

The Order to Show Cause and Temporary Restraining Order and supporting papers shall be served on Respondent/Defendant no later than 4-29-, 2020. Proof of such service shall be filed with the Court at least by May 8, 2020 ~~\_\_\_\_\_ court days prior to the hearing.~~


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Respondent/Defendant shall file and serve any response(s) to the Order to Show Cause no later than 6-24 -, 2020.
